BASIC TRAINING FOR ADULT LEADERS (to be considered “Trained”) depends on their role:

All leaders start with **Fast Start Orientation²**, **Youth Protection²** and **This Is Scouting²**. Then...

Cub Scouting: ..**Introduction to Cub Scouting FUN! + Cub Scout Leader Position-Specific Training**

Boy Scouting-Scoutmasters & ASMs: **SM Leader Specific Training + Intro. to Outdoor Leader Skills**

Boy Scouting-Others:.....**Troop Committee Challenge²**

Varsity: **Varsity Coach Leader Specific Training³ + Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills**

Venturing:..... **Venturing Leader Specific Training³**

NOTES: As of April 2009, **This Is Scouting** replaces New Leader Essentials.

Cub Scout leaders taking on a new position don't have to retake the entire sequence; they only need to take another Cub Scout Leader Position-Specific Training session for that new position. There are six types of sessions: Tiger Cub Den Leaders; Wolf & Bear Den Leaders; Webelos Den Leaders; Cubmasters; Pack Committee Members; and Pack Trainers.

Troop Committee Challenge training is also available on request as a 2-hr on-site session for a troop.

Outdoor Leader Skills for Webelos Den Leaders is part of the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.

REGISTRATION can be in-person at the Council Trading Post, over the phone, or on-line at the Council's website. Sign up early to make sure you have a seat!
